

100 chart MONEY directions

To make 10 sets you will need:

- 1 sheet of pennies (orange)
- 15 sheets of quarters (yellow)
- 10 sheets of dimes (blue)
- 5 sheets of nickels (red)
- 10 (2 sheet set) sets of the dollar (green)

You can print the 'clip art' coins, use rubber stamp coins, or get coin stickers from Oriental Trading (item: 12/1432 Coin Roll Stickers (200 pieces) Cost \$2.49 per roll)

Hinge the dollar and put stickers on BEFORE laminating.

Each student set consists of:

- 1 dollar (green)
- 3 quarters (yellow)
- 5 dimes (blue)
- 5 nickels (red)
- 5 pennies (orange)

Place everything in a gallon size ziplock bag.

I usually use 1 money set between 2 students (encourages solution conversations).

REAL COINS in a CIRCLE

Draw a 3-4 inch diameter circle in the right hand corner of a gallon ziplock bag with a permanent marker. Put student name on bag.

Ask PARENTS to place the following coins in bag for their child:

- 2 quarters
- 3 nickels
- 3 dimes
- 4 pennies
